Purpose

The Frost Foundation does not require or actively seek public recognition of its grantmaking. When an organization chooses to acknowledge the Foundation's support, we ask that it be done in keeping with these guidelines.

Acknowledging Foundation Support

Grantees are welcome to acknowledge the Frost Foundation's support publicly, and our name may be used for that purpose. Please refer to us as

without abbreviation or modification, unless agreed to in advance. References should be limited to the Foundation itself. Please do not name, quote, or reference individual board members, officers, employees, or family members without our prior written approval.
